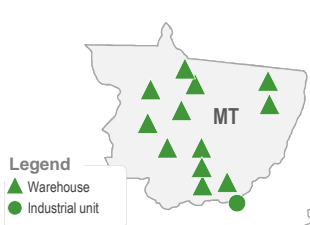
Transformation (Outcome across industry)

Warehouses and Crushing plants in the main soybean productive areas, outside the main deforestation frontiers

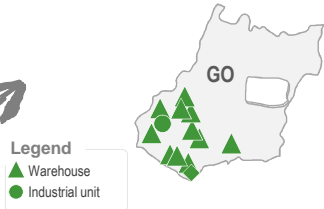
Mato Grosso

MT plant is located in the city of **Alto Araguaia** with a crushing capacity of 3ktons per day



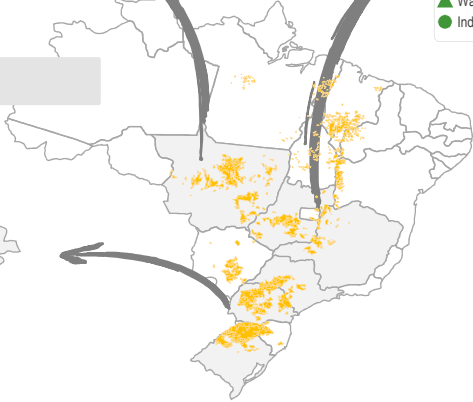
Goiás

GO plant is located in the city of **Jataí** with a crushing capacity of 2ktons per day

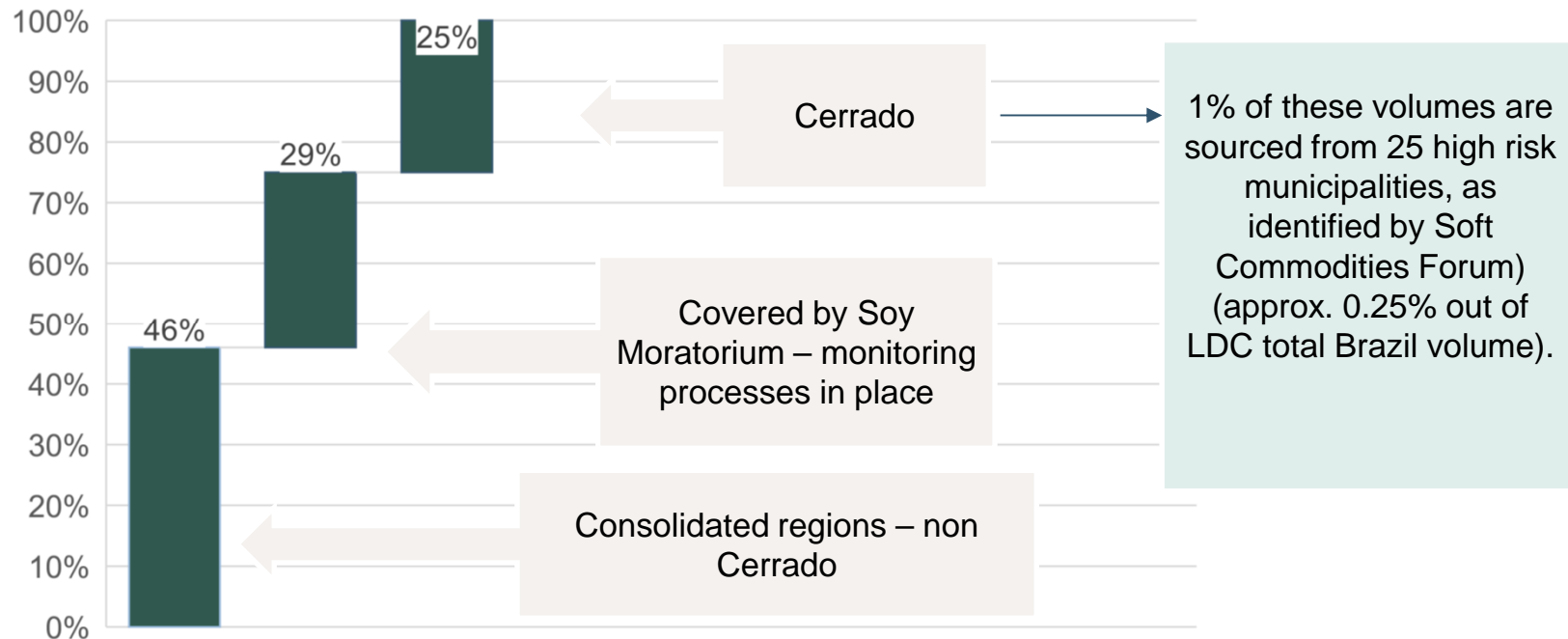


Paraná

Workstreams in Brazil

Certification of assets and expansion of RTRS & LDC sustainable agriculture program

Focus on traceability – approaching 40% of producers (Jan 2020)

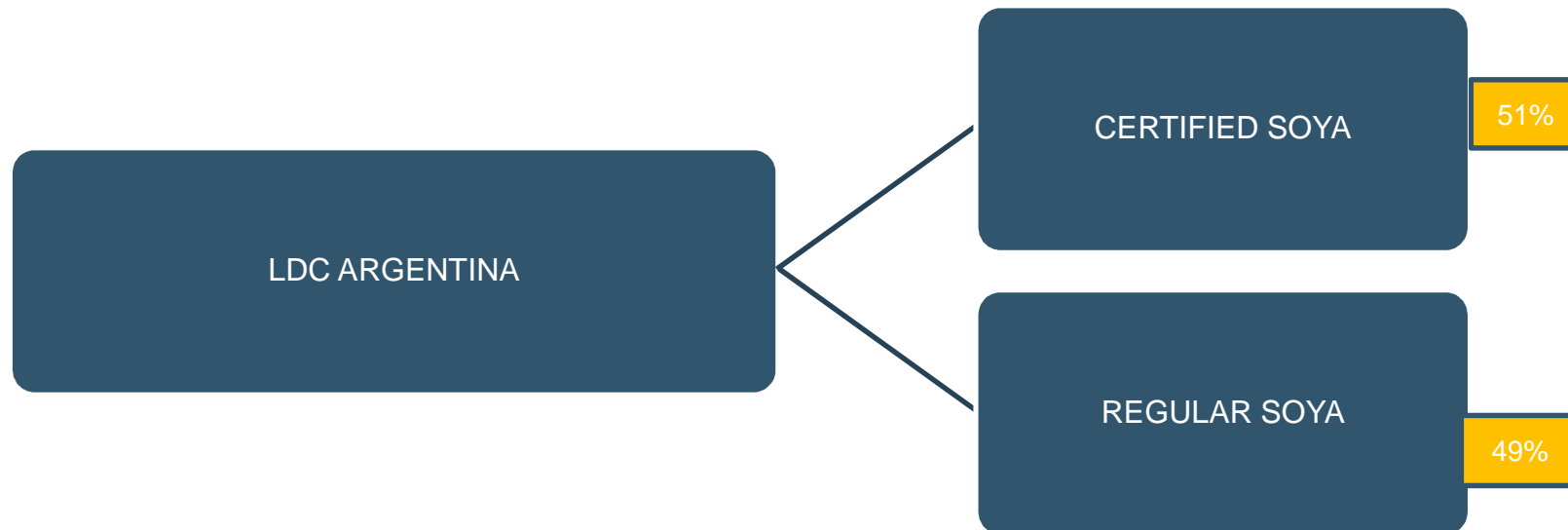
Long-term financial incentives tied to zero conversion/deforestation at a Producer Group level

Commitment to soy sector solutions (see TFA secondment)

Commitment to accelerating sector-led traceability and transparency (see Soft Commodity Forum)

Signatory of the Soy Moratorium in 2006 and ongoing monitoring (no purchase of soy from areas deforested from the Amazon since 2008)

Working actively with joint ventures (JV) partners in sustainability policy upgrade and underpinning processes where have minority stake in JV

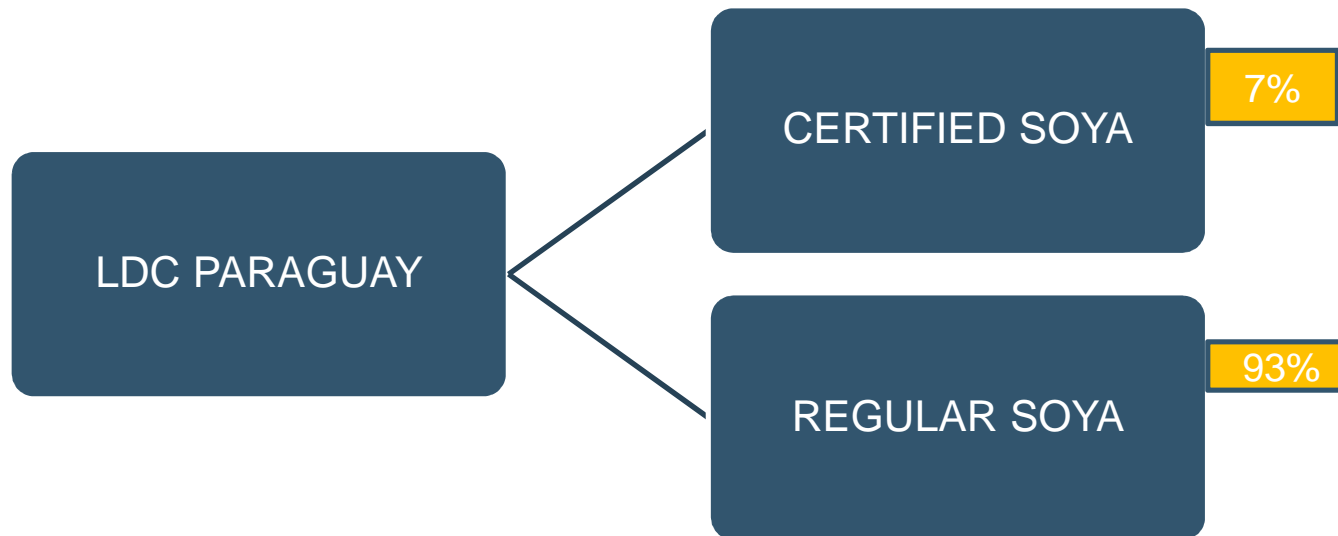
