## Louis Dreyfus Company Announces Its Investment Grade Rating by Standard & Poor's

**Rotterdam**, **The Netherlands**, November 13, 2020 - Louis Dreyfus Company B.V. (LDC) announced today that it has received its first public credit rating by *S&P Global Ratings* (S&P), which assigned an investment grade rating of BBB- with a positive outlook.

LDC has been active in the debt capital markets since 2012 and holds today three unrated senior bonds listed on the *Luxembourg Stock Exchange*. This initial public credit rating will give the Group broader access to the debt capital markets.

"This rating reflects the positive long-term outlook for our sector, recognizes LDC's solid track record of resilient results, and demonstrates confidence in the Group's ambitious strategy for a new stage of growth and development," said Patrick Treuer, LDC's Chief Financial Officer. "Following the strategic partnership signed this week, LDC is well positioned to accelerate its long-term business plan through investments across the value chain, in order to fulfill its crucial role for global food security and create value for shareholders, while maintaining discipline and prudence in financial and risk management."
