BASF and Louis Dreyfus Company Complete Sale and Purchase Transaction for BASF's Food and Health Performance Ingredients Business

Illertissen, Germany, and Rotterdam, the Netherlands, September 30, 2025 – BASF and Louis Dreyfus Company (LDC) announced today the successful completion of the sale of BASF's Food and Health Performance Ingredients Business, previously part of BASF's Nutrition & Health division, to Louis Dreyfus Company (LDC), following approval by the relevant authorities.

The transaction includes a production site in Illertissen, Germany, three application labs outside of Germany, as well as around 300 employees, who have transferred to LDC.

The **business activities in scope of the transaction** include:

- **Food performance ingredients**, such as whipping agents, emulsifiers and fat powders;
- **Health ingredients**, including plant sterol esters, conjugated linoleic acid (CLA) and omega-3 oils for human nutrition;
- as well as several smaller product lines.

Through this strategic step, BASF aims to sharpen its portfolio and support growth in prioritized market segments in Nutrition & Health, while LDC expands its participation in the rapidly growing plant-based ingredients market.

"By focusing on vitamins and carotenoids, we are reinforcing our strategic direction toward vital nutrition ingredients for both human and animal nutrition," emphasized Daniela Calleri, Senior Vice President Nutrition Ingredients at BASF. "We are committed to meeting market demand for high-quality ingredients and ensuring reliable supply for our customers worldwide."

"This move is a significant milestone in LDC's growth journey in the plant-based ingredients space, enhancing and accelerating our capacity to develop innovative solutions for food, personal care and healthcare applications," said James Zhou, LDC's Chief Commercial Officer and Head of Food & Feed Solutions. "We look forward to welcoming our new teams to the LDC family as we open this exciting new chapter for the Group and working together to create value for our customers around the world."

Both parties have agreed not to disclose financial details of the transaction.
